EXECUTIVE MINISTER (Written report) – Jim Kelsey

- 1.) Jillene Narraway has resigned as of 12/31/18, from her position as ABY Convention Director. We will be searching for a new person, to begin January 1st.
- 2.) Niagara Falls Mission trip July 12-15 at Community Mission, Inc,. 10 signed up so far. Some thoughts for another year:

- 1.) Two ordinations were recognized: Huong Holmes (Broome-Tioga) and Sheila Beers (Iroquois). Tragically, Sheila died suddenly this spring.
- 2.) Clergy Assessment Review committee meeting to review two pastors, Joe Perdue and Barrie-Lyn Foster, who are seeking recognition of their ordinations.
- 3.) Cedric Broughton is retiring as representative from the Mohawk-Oneida Association but will be the Ministers Council rep. It was MSC (Schultz/Trasoras) that we elect John Partise as Mohawk-Oneida representative to the ABCNYS Committee (unexpired term ending 2020).

- 1.) Proposed changes to the ABCNYS Bylaws
- a.) MSC(Woodruff/Cazer) unanimously that we recommend the adoption of the changes to Articles $\,3.1,\,3.2,\,$ and $\,3.3$ in the ABCNYS Bylaws, to be presented $\,$ and to be voted on by delegates at the $\,2018$ Biennial .
 - 2.) Proposed changes to the Rules of Procedures:
- a.) MSC (Sullivan/Malone) unanimously that we accept the changes to the ABCNYS Rules of Procedures in sections 1.1e, 1.3, 1.3a, 1.3b, and 1.3c and add recommended sections 5.2c and 5.2d.
- 3.) The actions will be shared in one issue of Paragraphs for Partners and will be postal mailed to each church so their delegates will be ready to vote on the Bylaw changes at Biennial.
 - 4.) Accumulated Earnings in the Youth Ministries Account
- a.) After discussion of the \$8,000 in this fund and how monies get into it, it was MSC (Malone/Cazer) unanimously that we give a gift of \$4,000 from the Youth Ministries account to Vick & Pathfinder Camp & Conference Ministries, to be used for camp scholarships for 2018.

- b.) Theme: "Finding Hope in Brokenness" with scripture theme as Isaiah 58:8a "Then your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your healing shall spring up quickly," (NRSV)
