The PSALM (Pastoral Support & Local Ministry) Fund is focused in two areas: to provide grants for pastoral support to congregations whose pastors' salaries are below a minimal level and to provide emergency grants directly to pastors and local ministries. The PSALM Fund is about congregations helping congregations; please place the PSALM Fund in your church's mission budget.

New Pastors Gathering. ABC/NYS hosts a one-day introduction and time of worship to pastors who are new to the Region and/or to the ministry.
