Requirements for Certificate in Lay Pastoral Studies

- Earn certificates outlined above.
- Maintain active membership in an ABC/NYS church.
- Consult regularly with a mentor appointed by your Association Lay Study Committee.
- Meet with representatives of the Association Lay Study Committee to plan and successfully complete an approved, supervised field work assignment.

Course Design and Fees

Structure Each course is 20 hours of class time and is designed for 10 two-hour sessions (may vary by class)

Fees The registration fee for each course is \$100.00. A family member living in the same house as a registered student and a person not taking the class for credit (audit) pay half the registration cost. Additional \$10 for online course. Cost of textbooks is in addition to the registration fee.

If a student chooses to withdraw from a course before the third class and notifies the instructor, the student may have their registration fee refunded.

Online Courses Students who take a course online will pay a \$10 additional charge to cover the cost of a technical support person.
