

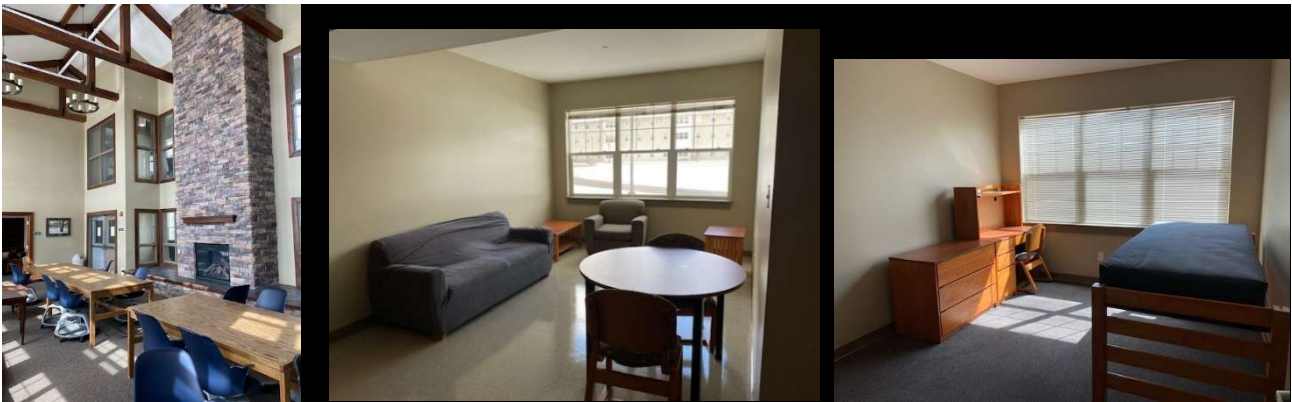
## FAQs FOR THE TUSCARORA MISSION PARTNERSHIP

### WHEN IS THE TRIP?

We will gather at the Tuscarora Indian Mission in Sanborn NY on Sunday evening, July 24<sup>th</sup>, for an orientation to the mission and its ministries and their cultural heritage. We will depart after breakfast on Saturday, July 30<sup>th</sup>.

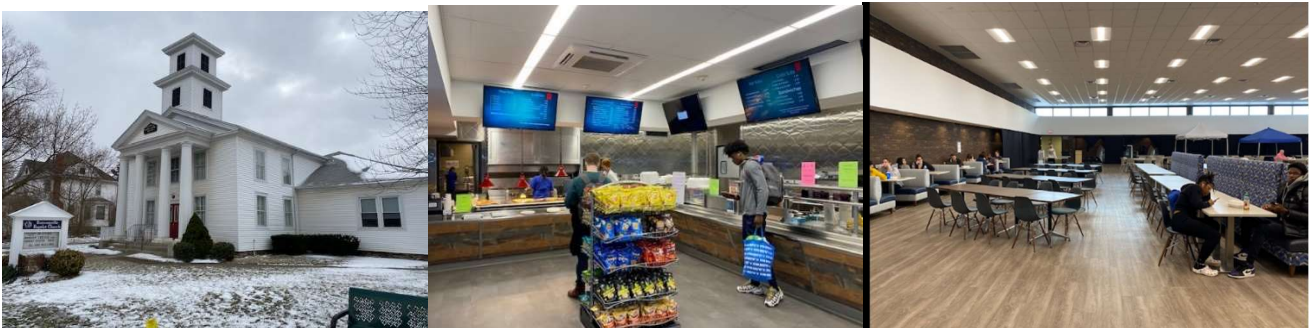
### WHERE WILL WE STAY?

We will stay in the dormitory at the Niagara County Community College. We will stay in suites with 4 or 5 private bedrooms and a small kitchen area. The building is air-conditioned and has some nice meeting areas.



### WHERE WILL WE EAT?

We will eat breakfast in the nearby school café. We will eat lunch at the Tuscarora Indian Mission church. Four evenings we will be provided a meal by the Ransomville Baptist Church. On one evening we will go out to eat.



### WHAT WILL WE DO?

The male trip participants will work with the mission “Silver Hammers” ministry doing basic maintenance, repair, landscaping, and/or whatever needs to be done. Be flexible and willing! The female trip participants will primarily be working alongside church members in their Vacation Bible School.

### WHO CAN GO ON THIS TRIP?

Adults and young people 12 or more years of age. Persons under 21 years of age will need to be accompanied by an adult. See the application for more information. No special skills are required apart from a willingness to serve, be flexible, and pleasant.

#### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost for the whole week is \$395 per person. This include most meals, housing and project/material costs. Each participant will be responsible for these additional costs: (1) the cost of breakfast (\$3.00 to \$7.00 per day for 4 days) and (2) the cost of one evening meal in a restaurant.
